Held annually, our flagship ICEF Berlin event gathers thousands of senior professionals from across the international education industry to forge new partnerships, reconnect with existing colleagues, and develop their recruitment strategies. This year, the 29th edition of the event saw **2,539 individuals** attending, 18% of whom were newcomers to Berlin. They represented **1,568 organisations** from across **114 countries**.

Over the course of three-days, **24,200 meetings** were held at the award-winning InterContinental Berlin.

A total of **1,055 educators, representing 547 institutions**, joined the event in Berlin.

They came from 39 countries, with the top 5 being: the UK (27%), the US (12%), Canada (10%), Spain (7%), and Germany (7%).

This year, agents came from 107 countries, with the top 5 being: Türkiye (9%), India (8%), Spain (7%), Italy (6%), and Germany (4%).

Service Providers

ICEF Berlin proved particularly popular with service providers supporting international student mobility. **283 representatives** joined from **117 organisations**. They came from 25 countries, with the top 5 being: the UK (32%), Canada (16%), Germany (8%), the US (7%), and Australia (5%).

Seminars & informal networking

ICEF Berlin is renowned for the breadth and depth of its professional development opportunities with this year being no exception. Over the course of the first day, delegates were able to choose from 40+ seminars, panel discussions, and informal "campfire" sessions, led by experts, academics, and senior leaders from across the sector. Key sessions this year included an update on the latest edition of our Agent Voice survey; a focus on ethical selling, with our panel debating the most important aspects of this fundamental topic; themed seminars providing the latest data, hints, and tips on key study destinations; an overview of the impact of AI in international student recruitment; a session on the shift away from the "big four" study destinations; and a debate around the issue of quality in international student recruitment.

As a key component of any ICEF event, evening receptions create the necessary space for delegates to cement new partnerships and renew existing friendships in a more informal setting. This year, delegates were able to enjoy a welcome reception sponsored by <u>Coquitlam School District #43</u>, providing the perfect opportunity to get acquainted while, on the second day, a dinner sponsored by <u>MLA</u> provided ICEF Berlin with a memorable conclusion.

Great Delegate Feedback

Over the course of its 30-year history, ICEF has become renowned for the outstanding organisation of its events. We are always working to ensure that delegates are provided with the best environment, facilities, and support in order to facilitate efficient and productive meetings.

In the after-event survey for ICEF Berlin, the organisation of the event, as well as the support and level of communication provided by the ICEF team, were rated as **good or excellent by 98% and 95%** respectively. This feedback demonstrates our ongoing commitment to ensuring each ICEF event is the best it can be.

90% rated the number and quality of new contacts they made as good or excellent.

For 33% of the respondents, this was their first ICEF event, and we look forward to welcoming them back in the future.
